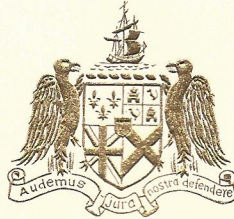

RECOGNIZING SEPTEMBER 27, 2015, AS ALABAMA FIRST RESPONDERS APPRECIATION DAY

WHEREAS, there have been more than 20,000 public safety officers killed in the line of duty nationally, with over 522 killed in the line of duty in the State of Alabama; and

WHEREAS, as of November 2014, 24 firefighters had lost their lives in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, all first responders place their lives at risk each time they respond to a call, now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That this body hereby recognizes September 27, 2015, as Alabama First Responders Appreciation Day, and each citizen in the state is encouraged to remember the sacrifices made by first responders and express their thanks to all first responders on that date.
