CONDITIONAL LOAN TRANSFER FORM

Pursuant to Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs ("ADECA") Surplus Property Division, Chapter 305-9-1-.11 of the Alabama Administrative Code, and AL Code § 41-4-33.2, and with the condition that the requirements of Chapter 305-9-1-.11(1)(a)-(g) have all been met, the ADECA Surplus Property Division hereby loans to _____ (name of rescue squad/ambulance service) the following property:

(Description of property (number of items, make, model, or any other identifying characteristics)).

In the case of damage to, or loss or theft of, the property, you shall immediately notify the ADECA Surplus Property Division.

Any repairs to said property shall be the responsibility of the rescue squad or ambulance service.

Pursuant to ADECA Surplus Property Division, Chapter 305-9-1-.11 of the Alabama Administrative Code, each rescue squad or ambulance service which has been loaned property by the Surplus Property Division must:

1. Maintain an inventory of all such property along with current pictures; AND,
2. Submit the inventory to the Surplus Property Division on an annual basis.

In accordance with AL Code § 41-4-33.2(c), the property that is the subject of this transfer "shall be used exclusively for ambulance and rescue purposes. The use of any such property other than on the business of the volunteer ambulance service or rescue squad is expressly prohibited. Any violation of the provision of this section shall be a Class A misdemeanor punishable as provided under Title 13A." Additionally, if the property is found to be used for any purpose other than for ambulance and rescue purposes, the property shall be immediately returned to the ADECA Surplus Property Division and this agreement shall be terminated.
